I. OVERTURE

[Lento]

The score is for the Overture of 'Music for the Royal Fireworks' by George Frideric Handel, arranged by Eigar Howarth. It is in C major and 4/4 time. The tempo is marked [Lento]. The score includes parts for Trumpet I (doubling Piccolo Trumpet), Trumpets II and III, Flagehorn (doubling Cornet), Horns I, II, and III, Trombones I, II, and III, Euphonium, Tuba, and Timpani. The music begins with a series of eighth-note patterns in the brass and woodwinds, followed by a more rhythmic section. Dynamics include *poco f* and *f*.
