# All My Loving

This is the first song that Paul wrote where the words came first—he thought of the words while shaving one day. The band's second album, *With The Beatles*, was the first British album to sell a million records in the UK.

**Hints & Tips:** As the instruction at the beginning suggests, this song should be played at quite a fast pace. Notice that the left hand is really playing 'broken chords', so you could try in places to keep your fingers on the keys you will need.
