This mid-tempo ballad from Morrison's second studio album *Songs For You, Truths for Me* about the struggle at the close of a relationship that is beyond repair, became his most successful single to date by breaking into the UK Top 10 following his live performance of the song on UK TV with Girls Aloud.

Hints & Tips: Unusually this arrangement puts the melody of the verse in the left hand which, because it is used in the main to provide simple accompaniments, tends to be weaker than the right hand. Practise the scales of D major and B minor in the left hand only to build up strength.
