The last Beatles single to be released, 'Let It Be' was issued on 6th March 1970. It is one of a few Beatles songs that exists in more than one authorised version. It was thought to be a plea for the Beatles to make their peace with each other as they started their solo careers.

**Hints & Tips:** This piece has an almost hymn-like quality. Try to play it with appropriate solemnity. Play the more complex rhythms in a more relaxed and unperturbed way.
